

WaterSavers™ Criteria

ALL PARTICIPANTS

- All water discharge must be routed to water treatment or a leech/septic field as permitted.
- A back flow prevention device must be installed and operable on the potable water supply.
- All spray nozzles shall be inspected annually to ensure maximum efficiency of water used.
- All water-saving devices must be maintained to original or improved specifications for the conservation of water.
- Spot-free reverse osmosis concentrate (a.k.a. “reject”), if such a system is used, must be reused in the wash process.

ADDITIONALLY

A wash must reclaim or recycle its water for future wash cycles.

OR



CONVEYORIZED WASHES

Maximum of no more than **40 gallons** of potable/fresh water per wash for all wash packages combined.



IN-BAY/ROLL-OVER WASHES

Maximum of no more than **40 gallons** of potable/fresh water per wash for any wash package offered.



SELF-SERVICE WASHES

Maintain high-pressure wash nozzles and pump systems that use **3 gallons per minute** or less.
